2016 International Classic and Modern 2 Day Trial (5th - 6th March)

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Jurisdiction – The competition shall be open to all riders and held in association with the AMCA Trials rules.
2. Entries to be forwarded to Mrs. S. du Feu, Haut de la Vallee, Rue de la Vallee, St Mary, JE3 3DL on an approved form accompanied by the entry fee of £30.00 no later than 31st January 2016
3. Entry fees will include third party insurance and accident premium in association with Alexander Parkes Insurance Brokers. All claims are made direct to the AMCA.
 - a) Classes – Expert, Clubman, Sportsmans, Twin-Shock(Premier and Sportsmans), Pre 65(Premier and Sportsman), Air cooled monoshock(Premier and Sportsmans)
4. Maximum entries – 150 on a first come first to be accepted basis.
5. Conditions of machine – all machines must be in a roadworthy condition, complete with tax disc, horn and speedometer in working order. Registration numbers must be clearly discernible.
6. The route does include use of the public highway and environmentally sensitive areas (no fuel/oil leaks)
 - a) Route sections must be taken in their correct sequence.
7. Marking Rules – NON STOP
8. System of marking – Observed
9. Starting at intervals of half a minute.
10. Route marking with arrows.
11. Course marking - dual sections, Experts red pennants. Clubman, Pre 65 Premier Twin-Shock Premier and Air cooled monoshock Premier Blue pennants. Sportsmans Pre65 Sportsmans, Twin-Shock Sportsmans and Air cooled monoshock Sportsmans white pennants.
12. Awards – Pre 65 Premier (winner and runner-up), Pre 65 Sportsmans (winner and runner-up), Twin-Shock Premier (winner and runner-up), Twin-Shock Sportsmans (winner and runner-up), Expert (winner and runner-up), Clubman (winner and runner-up), Sportsmans (winner and runner-up), (Air cooled monoshock (Premier winner and Sportsmans winner.) Best Female rider, best overseas rider in a Premier class, best Jersey rider in a Premier class and best Youth rider (losing the least points in any class)
13. Numbers – competition numbers will be issued at the start of the event. Numbers will correspond with starting positions, which shall be drawn before the start of the event.
14. Officials – to be advised.
15. Clothing – All riders must wear crash helmets at all times throughout the competition to comply with the Jersey Law. Suitable clothing is recommended including protective boots and gloves.
16. The event is open to solos only.
17. Overall time limit 5 ½ hours.
18. Number of sections – 15
 - a) Number of laps – 3
19. Signing on – 45 minutes before start of event.
20. The Committee reserves the right to alter any section.
21. Results – Provisional Results will be available on the Sunday evening of the event at The Ambassadeur Hotel. Official Results will be posted on the Club Website within 7 days.
22. The Committee reserves the rights to exclude from the results any rider who abuses any Official whether verbally or otherwise.
