This event is organised and run by the Jersey Classic and Modern Trials Club

1. Jurisdiction – The competition shall be open to all riders and held in association with the AMCA Trials rules.

2. Entries to be forwarded to:

on an approved form accompanied by the entry fee of £40.00 no later than 31st January 2018.

3. Entry fees will include third party insurance and accident premium in association with Alexander Parkes Insurance Brokers. All claims are made direct to the AMCA

4. Classes –

- Expert
- Clubman
- Sportsman
- Twin-Shock (Premier and Sportsman)
- Pre 65 (Premier and Sportsman)
- Air-cooled mono-shock (Premier and Sportsman)
- Twin-Shock/Pre 65 for riders under 40 years of age (Premier and Sportsman)

5. Maximum entries – 150 on a first come first to be accepted basis.

6. Conditions of machine – all machines must be in a roadworthy condition, complete with, horn and speedometer in working order. Registration numbers must be clearly discernible.

7. The route does include use of the public highway and environmentally sensitive areas (no fuel/oil leaks)

8. Route sections must be taken in their correct sequence.

9. Marking Rules – NON STOP

10. System of marking – Observed

11. Starting at intervals of half a minute.

12. Route marking with arrows.

13. Course marking - dual sections,

- Experts red pennants

- Clubman, Pre 65 Premier, Twin-Shock Premier and Air cooled mono-shock Premier, Blue pennants
- Sportsman, Pre65 Sportsman, Twin-Shock Sportsman and Air-cooled mono-shock Sportsman, white pennants.

14. Awards –

- Pre 65 Premier (winner and runner-up)
- Pre 65 Sportsman (winner and runner-up)
- Twin-Shock Premier (winner and runner-up)
- Twin-Shock Sportsman (winner and runner-up)
- Expert (winner and runner-up)
- Clubman (winner and runner-up)
- Sportsman (winner and runner-up)
- Air-cooled mono-shock (Premier winner and Sportsman winner)
- Best Female rider
- Best overseas rider in a Premier class
- Best Jersey rider in a Premier class
- Twin-Shock/Pre 65 under 40 years of age (Premier and Sportsman, winner and runner-up)

15. Numbers – competition numbers will be issued at the start of the event. Numbers will correspond with starting positions, which shall be drawn before the start of the event.

16. Officials – to be advised.

17. Clothing – All riders must wear crash helmets at all times throughout the competition to comply with the Jersey Law. Suitable clothing is recommended including protective boots and gloves.

18. The event is open to solos only.

19. Overall time limit 5 ½ hours.

20. Number of sections – 15

21. Number of laps – 3

22. Signing on – 45 minutes before start of event.

23. The Committee reserves the right to alter any section.

24. Results – Provisional Results will be available on the Sunday evening of the event at The Ambassadeur Hotel. Official Results will be posted on the Club Website within 7 days.

25. The Committee reserves the rights to exclude from the results any rider who abuses any Official whether verbally or otherwise.
